Terms & Conditions

ADULT ENTRY LIMITS

- 1.Limit of 6 entries in each Art Category
 - o Painting on Board or Canvas, Works on Paper, 3D Any Medium.
- 2.Limit of 5 entries in Photography Category.
- 3.Limit of 3 entries in each Textile Category.

ENTRY FORMS AND FEES

- 1. Entry Forms with fees must be submitted by Monday 11th August 2025:

- 2. Entry fees are to be paid by Monday 11th August 2025:

3. Adult entry fees:

- o \$20 per entry if using collection services.
- o \$10 per entry if personal delivery.
- 4. There will be no refunds of entry fees paid.

STUDENTS

- 1.Limit of 3 entries per student, including any sculpture.
- 2.If students want to enter Photography or Textiles, adult conditions apply (entry forms must be used and adult entry fees paid).
- 3.2D or 3D Artwork is acceptable. If 2D, artwork must not exceed A3 size.
- 4. All artwork must have secure wiring/stringing for hanging. (Not applicable to 3D work).
- 5.Entry form must be completed and relevant entry fees paid.

6. Student entry fees:

- \$2 per Art category entry.
- o Adult fees are payable for Photography and Textiles.
- $\circ~$ If using the collection service, a collection service fee of \$10 applies to each item.
- 7.Entries must be original work and suitable for exhibition.
- 8.Entries may be sold only with parent/teacher permission.

CONDITIONS

- 1. Art entries must have good quality and secure wiring/stringing for hanging.
- 2. Photography entries must be mounted or framed and be suited to hanging. (i.e. photo does not have to be framed but must be suitable for hanging).
- 3. Entries must be original work and suitable for exhibition (all work completed and dry).
- 4. Textiles must be fitted with sleeve or hoops for hanging.
- 5.Each entry must be clearly and securely marked on the back/bottom of the artwork with section, category, title, artist's name, address & selling price if for sale.
- 6. Entries must not have been exhibited at a previous Dalwallinu Arts Festival.
- 7.Personally delivered entries will only be accepted by stewards at the Dalwallinu Recreation Centre on Tuesday 9th September 2025 between 9.30am & 1.30pm.
- 8.Entries must be collected and signed for between 4pm & 5pm on Saturday 13th September 2025 (unless using Collection Centres).
- 9.Entries not claimed by 30th September 2025 will become the property of Dalwallinu Creative Arts Incorporated.
- 10.Insurance is the artists responsibility. Dalwallinu Creative Arts Inc. and it's volunteers will take all reasonable care but no responsibility for exhibits will be accepted.
- 11. We highly recommend artists insure their work against loss or damage whilst at a collection centre, in transit and whilst in our custody.
- 12. Entries will be accepted and displayed at the discretion of the committee.
- 13.All entries must comply with Australian Law and regulations and is the full responsibility of the artist.
- 14. Artists agree to their work being reproduced in print, film or digital format for promotional, educational and documentational purposes.
- 15. To exhibit large sculptures please contact the Secretary for more information.
- 16.Late entries and amendments to entry forms after submission will be at the committee's discretion.
- 17. Failure to comply with entry conditions will render the entry ineligible.

PRIZES AND COMMISSIONS ON WORKS SOLD

- 1. The Most Outstanding Entry prize winner is not eligible to win the Public Selection Prize.
- 2. Judges' decisions are final. The Committee reserves the right of the judges to withhold prizes in any section.
- 3.A commission of 20% on all items sold will be charged and must be factored into the price advertised by the artist.

COLLECTION CENTRES

Conditions for those using the collection centres below:

- 1.Exhibits must be boxed and clearly marked with Artist's name, collection return address plus the quantity of artworks and the name of each marked piece.
- 2. Sculptures are unable to be accepted at collection centres, personal delivery to the festival only.
- 3.Each item must be individually wrapped in adequate protective wrapping and marked with its title before being placed in its package.
- 4. Dalwallinu Creative Arts Inc. reserves the right to reject any poorly packaged entries.
- 5.All entries must be dropped off to collection centres by the 6th September please see below for specific delivery dates that apply to each of the collection centres.
- 6. Unsold exhibits will be returned to the nominated address on the entry form.
 - o For Perth: on Monday 15th September 2025.
 - o For Northam: by Monday 22nd September 2025.
- 7. Please call collection centre beforehand to confirm delivery and pick up.
